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### 1. Introduction

#### 1.1 Harlaxton Energy Networks Limited - Distribution Business

Harlaxton Energy Networks Limited are an independent electricity distribution business, licensed to design, build, adopt, operate and maintain electricity distribution networks in Great Britain.

This statement has been prepared in a form approved by Ofgem.

#### 1.2 Purpose of this Statement

This statement sets out the basis upon which charges will be made for the provision of metering point administration services to enable a supplier to make a reasonable estimate of charges it would be liable to pay for the provision of such services. It is prepared in accordance with the requirements of Harlaxton Energy Networks electricity distribution licence issued under the Electricity Act 1989 (as amended by the Utilities Act 2000) and the Master Registration Agreement (MRA).

This statement describes the process for obtaining metering point administration services. This statement also details the costs for each activity which are not included with Harlaxton's distribution use of system charges (DuoS).

It should be noted that Harlaxton Energy Networks are not currently a meter operator (MOP) and therefore does not charge for MOP services.

#### 1.3 Persons Entitled to Apply for Metering Point Administration Services

An applicant applying for the use of Harlaxton Energy Networks metering point administration services, in relation to Harlaxton Energy's network, must be a licensed Electricity Supplier and a signatory to the Master Registration Agreement (MRA) and the Distribution Connection Use of System Agreement (DCUSA). Harlaxton Energy Networks are also required by its licence to establish or procure data transfer services, these services are provided under contract by Electralink. 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#### 1.4 Procedure for Applying for Metering Point Administration Services

Applicants will be required to enter into an agreement with Harlaxton Energy Networks prior to using the services. This agreement will set out the obligation of both parties, service levels, methods of communicating information and invoicing and payment arrangements.

Where an agreement cannot be reached within a reasonable period then either party may request settlement by the Chairman of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority.

# 2. Charges for Metering Point Services

#### 2.1. Basis of Charges

The normal operating costs of providing a metering point administration service (MPAS) are included with Harlaxton Energy Networks distribution use of system charges (DuoS).

If an electricity Supplier should request additional services then a transaction charge will be levied by Harlaxton. A table of these charges are provided in Section 2.2 overleaf. The charges detailed overleaf are exclusive of VAT.
